Fee Schedule

Guidance and Instructions for Ship Owners, Managers, Masters, Seafarers, Maritime Training Institutions and Manning Agents

1. Purpose

- 1.1. This Bulletin lists the approved fees in effect as at 17 January 2019.
- 1.2. It should be noted that with effect from 01 July 2011, no "Registration Fee" has been applied to any ship joining the Register.
- 1.3. This Bulletin should be read in conjunction with the relevant BMA Information Bulletins that provide additional details/clarity on the service being performed.
- 1.4. For the purpose of this Bulletin, a ship refers to any vessel/unit including all private (non-commercial) and charter (commercial) yachts.
- 1.5. Fees stated in this Bulletin are in Bahamian dollars.
- 1.6. Payment is also accepted in US dollars (\$), pounds sterling (£) and Euro (€), or by credit card.
