- ii. Finger injury during recovery of daughter craft
- iii. Workboat failed during transfer operations due to fuel contamination
- iv. Vessel/platform collision – mooring bollard broken by vessel
- v. Accidental mixing of different fuel oils
- vi. Unexpected release of water during annual maintenance of CO2 fixed firefighting system
