This Marine Notice supersedes BMA Information Bulletin No.81 Rev.17

1. Purpose

- 1.1. This Marine Notice (MN) lists the approved fees in effect as at 17 February 2021.
- 1.2. This MN should be read in conjunction with the relevant BMA Information Bulletins, Marine Notices and Information Notices that provide additional details on the service being performed.
- 1.3. For the purpose of this MN, a ship refers to any vessel/unit including all private (non-commercial) and charter (commercial) yachts.
- 1.4. Fees stated in this MN are in Bahamian dollars.
- 1.5. Payment is also accepted in US dollars (\$), pounds sterling (£) and Euro (€), or by credit card.

2.1. Registration Fee

2.1.1. With effect from 01 July 2011, no "Registration Fee" has been applied to any ship joining the Register.
