- 3.2. EyeSea has developed the concept of using geotagged pictures to chart maritime pollution using a simple application (app). The EyeSea App is an easy-to-use mobile phone application used by volunteers to record and submit images and locations of pollution across the world.
- 3.3. EyeSea would like the help of the maritime community to help to identify and locate ocean, coastal, and waterway pollution, by simply taking a picture of marine pollution using the EyeSea App.
